



# RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

EFFECTIVE January 18, 2022

WHEREAS, The City of Providence has a citywide speed limit of 25 miles per hour; and



WHEREAS, There have been multiple occasions of severe accidents on Allens Avenue that have put the residents and drivers' safety at risk; and

WHEREAS, In 2016 the Providence Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Commission recommended lowering the speed limit on Allens Avenue from 35 miles per hour to 25 miles per hour.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Providence City Council hereby requests that the Rhode Island Department of Transportation and the traffic engineer reduce the speed limit on Allens Avenue from 35 miles per hour to 25 miles per hour for public safety concerns and to be consistent with the speed limit on the length of Allens Avenue that extends to the City of Cranston.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That upon passage, copies of this resolution be transmitted to the Honorable Mayor of Providence, the Rhode Island Department of Transportation, and the Traffic Engineer.
