

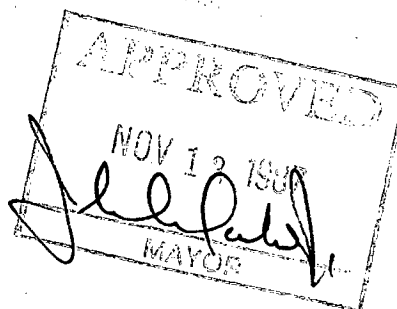


Dear Mike:

This is per our telephone conversation regarding the installation of a flood lamp on an existing utility pole for my agency, the Urban Educational Center.

Specifically, the flood lamp should be installed on the westerly side of Prairie Avenue, Pole #271, or the second location would be the northern side of Somerset Street on Pole #30. 



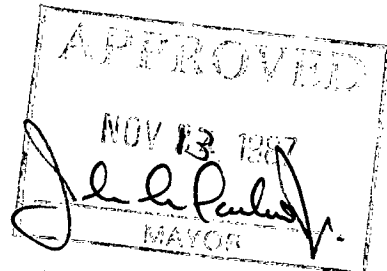
