

Re: Proposed street name change from Matthews Street to Times<sup>2</sup> Way.

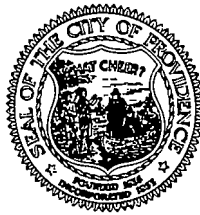
Dear Ms. Stetson
