

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 42-11-10 of the General Laws of the State of Rhode  
2 Island entitled "Statewide planning Program" is hereby amended to read as follows:

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4 (e) Membership of state planning council. The state planning counsel shall  
5 consist of:

6 (1) The director of the department of administration as chairperson;

7 (2) The director, policy office, in the office of the governor, as vice-  
8 chairperson;

9 (3) The governor, or his or her designee;

10 (4) The budget officer;

11 (5) The director of the office of housing, energy and intergovernmental  
12 relations;

13 (6) The associate director of administration for planning, as secretary;

14 (7) The president of the league of cities and towns or his or her designee and  
15 one official of local government, who shall be appointed by the governor from a list  
16 of not less than three (3) submitted by the Rhode Island league of cities and towns;  
17 and

18 (8) The executive director of the league of cities and towns;

19 (9) The speaker of the house or his or her designee;

1 (10) The senate majority leader or his or her designee;

2 (11) Four (4) public members, three (3) who shall be appointed by the  
3 governor, and one of whom shall be appointed by the speaker of the house for terms  
4 of three (3) years;

5 (12) The mayor of the City of Providence or his or her designee.

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SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect upon passage.
