SAILORS.


COUNCIL PRESIDENT PAOLINO calls for nominations for Superintendent of Burial of Deceased Soldiers and Sailors for the ensuing term of Four Years ending on the first Monday in January, 1987.

COUNCILMAN GLAVIN nominates HENRY BOUDREAU of Providence, this nomination is seconded by COUNCILMAN DILLON.

COUNCIL PRESIDENT PAOLINO calls for further nominations and there being none, on motion of COUNCILMAN GLAVIN, seconded by COUNCILMAN DILLON, it is voted that nominations be closed and the Clerk is directed to cast one ballot for HENRY BOUDREAU.

The Clerk casts one ballot as directed.

COUNCIL PRESIDENT PAOLINO thereupon declares HENRY BOUDREAU, duly elected as Superintendent of Burial of Deceased Soldiers and Sailors, for the ensuing term of Two Years, ending on the First Monday in January, 1985.
