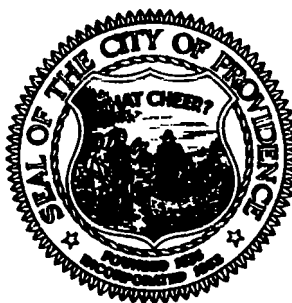



Ms. Castro will fill the unexpired term of Mr. Thomas Scorpio who has resigned.



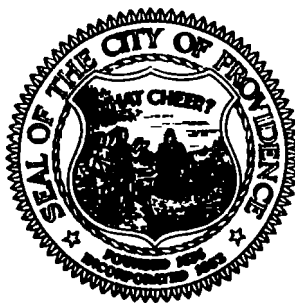

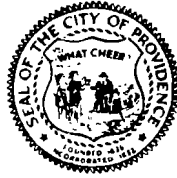
