AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO ART. IV, CHAPTER 17, SECTION 17-189(5) OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES

Approved June 25, 1999

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the language of Section 17-189(5) of the Code of Ordinances which provides that "[t]he application to accomplish such [accidental disability] retirement must be filed within eighteen (18) months of the date of the accident," the Retirement Board of the City of Providence, upon the request of the Commissioner of Public Safety, may consider and act upon the accidental disability retirement applications of Police Officer Michael LaMarra, Police Officer Brian Quirk, Firefighter Robert Tavarozzi and Firefighter Roger Farmer, even though more than eighteen (18) months have passed since the date of the accident which is the averred proximate cause of each of the above-named applicants for a disability retirement allowance.

SECTION 2. Said applications shall be subject to and considered in accordance with all other applicable ordinances, regulations, standards and practices relating to accidental disability retirement applications.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.

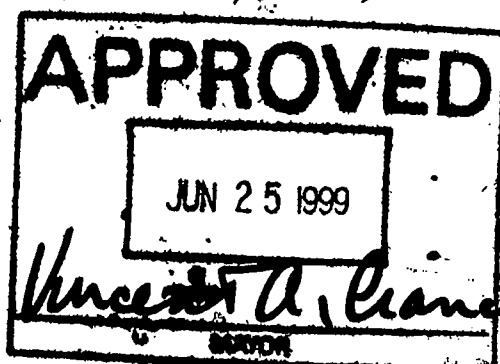
