AN ACT

IN AMENDMENT OF CHAPTER 15, PUBLIC LAWS OF 1966, ENTITLED "AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY TAX ASSESSOR OF THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE TO ADJUST THE ASSESSED VALUATION OF EXISTING DWELLINGS USED FOR RESIDENTIAL PURPOSES TO REFLECT CHANGES IN MARKET OR RECENT MARKET VALUE FOR RESIDENTIAL PURPOSES"

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 1 of Chapter 15 of the Public Laws, 1966, entitled "An act authorizing the City Tax Assessor of the City of Providence to abate any increase in assessed valuation resulting from alterations and improvements to existing dwellings or portion of such dwellings used for residential purposes" is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 1. The city tax assessor of the city of Providence may abate any increase in the assessed valuation of any local tax resulting from alterations and improvements made to existing dwellings used for residential purposes for a period of five (5) years beginning with the assessment date immediately following the completion of the alterations and improvements to the extent that such increase in assessed valuation results from such alterations and improvements; provided, however, that such alteration or improvement must be commenced between June 1, 1966 and June 1, 1970, and must be completed within two (2) years of the date of commencement. The assessed valuation of such dwelling and of the land on which it is situated, exclusive of the increase in valuation which is so abated shall not, after such alterations and improvements, exceed the valuation appearing on the assessment rolls on the assessment

date immediately preceding the commencement of such alterations and improvements; provided, however, that each dwelling and land shall be subject to any general revaluation done on a citywide basis.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage and all acts and parts of acts inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

AN ACT

IN AMENDMENT OF AND IN ADDITION TO CHAPTER 11-44 OF THE GENERAL LAWS, 1956, ENTITLED "TRESPASS AND VANDALISM".

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 11-44 of the General Laws, 1956, entitled "Trespass and Vandalism", is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:

"11-44-22. Injury to Fire Department Property - Any person who shall willfully destroy or damage any of the property or apparatus of a fire department or volunteer fire company, or steal or misappropriate the same or any part thereof; or willfully interfere with any member of a fire department or volunteer fire company, while in the performance of his duty shall be deemed to have committed a felony and shall be imprisoned not less than one year nor more than three years or by a fine of not more than Fifteen Hundred (\$1500) Dollars or by both.

SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect upon its passage and all acts or parts of acts inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

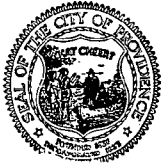

Dear Councilman Beatini:

In answer to the Honorable Committee on Public Welfare concerning "Ice Skating Rink in Merino Park Complex" I can give you information on the long range viewpoint and also what is being done about skating opportunities at the present time.

The administration is investigating the economic feasibility of constructing artificial ice skating rinks and Merino Park is being considered as a possible site for a rink.

Flooding the existing area prior to the coming of cold weather is not possible because the water keeps seeping into the ground. This winter however, because of the extreme cold weather, flooding was accomplished on frozen ground and a good sheet of ice is now available and the skating surface is good on this date January 22, 1968.
