Approved August 14, 1998

WHEREAS, On Friday, July 24, 1998 a gunman burst through a security checkpoint killing two Capitol Police Officers, and wounding a female tourist in the United States Capitol, and

WHEREAS, Officers Jacob J. Chestnut an eighteen year veteran with less than a year from retirement and John Gibson, an eight year veteran, laid down their lives protecting all of the people coming in and out of the building, and

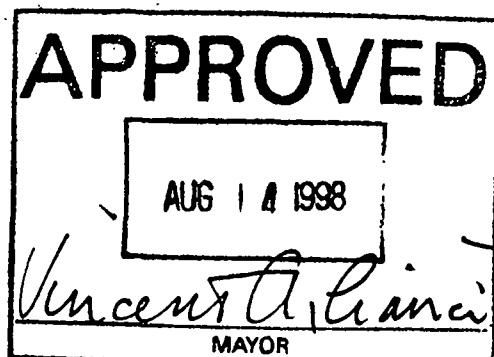
WHEREAS, These honorable men were married and had families that they loved, and this has been taken away by a deranged man who had been in and out of mental hospitals for a number of years, and

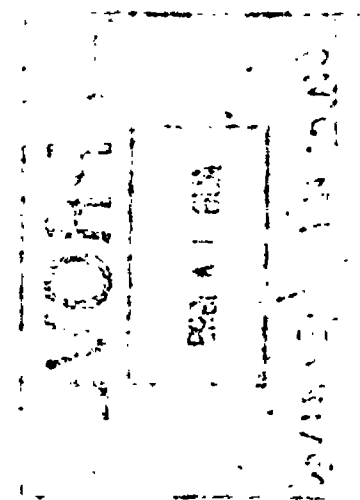
WHEREAS, It has been said by many at the United States Capitol, that these men were well liked by all lawmakers and employees of the Capitol, and therefore, it is only fitting that these two officers be laid to rest in the Arlington National Cemetery with military honors.

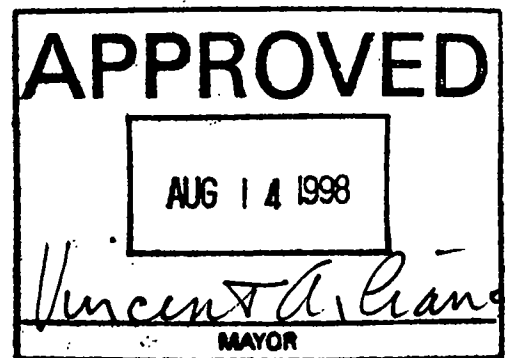
