No. **649** AN ORDINANCE IN AMENDMENT OF CHAPTER 4,
ARTICLE II OF THE REVISED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY
OF PROVIDENCE (1946) ENTITLED "DOGS".

Approved October 2, 1953

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

Section 1. Article II of Chapter 4 of the
Revised Ordinances of the City of Providence
(1946) entitled "Dogs" is hereby amended by
adding thereto Section 7.5 to be inserted between
sections numbered 7 and 8, said new section to
read as follows:

The Superintendent of Health may order
the quarantine and confinement for obser-
vation for a period of not more than
fifteen (15) days of any dog which has
bitten a human being, and the exercise
of such authority shall not require any
declaration by the Superintendent of Health
that there is any danger of rabies.

Sec. 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon
its passage.


SUBJECT: Referral No. 538 - REDEMPTION OF LOT 8 on ASSESSOR'S
