






The owner of the restaurant MiConuco is Mr. Filipe Moronta who has been an asset to the neighborhood and as you know we welcome individuals like Mr. Moronta. He has also expressed concerns with regards to passer byers as well as customers complaining and expressing their concerns about the conditions of the sidewalks in front of their business. Ms. Carmen Pena and her tenants have also expressed the need of the sidewalk being repaired. I know this past winter has been very difficult for roads, sidewalks and structures in general. I hope that you will be able to do some corrective preventative measures with regards to the conditions of the sidewalks in front of both these two structures and even further if needed if you agree along other areas on Westminster Street.
