RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 447

Approved May 9, 1979

WHEREAS, On April 25, 1979 a three alarm blaze was reported at the Brown and Sharpe Complex which was brought under control within two hours, and

WHEREAS, Fire Fighters from our neighboring communities Cranston, Pawtucket, and East Providence spared no efforts in performing their duties to control the fire which threatened neighboring buildings and from which fire balls were visible in the neighboring area, and

WHEREAS, Although the members of the Fire Department and Police Department were hindered in their duties by the many spectators who lined on the road ways and obstructed the narrow streets to the complex, serious damage did not occur in the neighboring buildings,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the City Council hereby commends the Members of the Fire Department, and Police Department and the Arson Squad upon their gallant and dedicated Services rendered during the fire at the Brown and Sharpe Complex.
