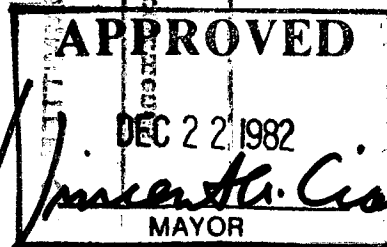
THE CITY COUNCIL



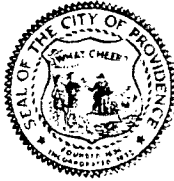

Dear Mr. Malin:

In response to the Resolution before the City Council to get an accounting of the proceeds of the Charles H. Smith Scholarship Fund. I respectfully request the following the information:

1. The amount of the Fund.
2. The amount of the yearly income.
3. A copy of any and all reports for the last twenty-five years concerning the disbursement of the proceeds of the said Fund.
4. A copy of the instrument and guidelines by which you distribute said proceeds.
5. The names and addresses of all students from Rhode Island attending Harvard University for the last five (5) years.
6. Any other information which you may deem helpful and informative in regard to the administration of the Smith Scholarship Fund.

It only makes good common sense for the Providence City Council, in discharging its obligations to the citizens of the City of Providence, to inquire into these matters, especially in view of the fact that the Fund is intended for residents of the City of Providence. Residents of the other cities or towns in the State of Rhode Island do not, as you know, stand on the same footing, or priority, and the rights of Providence residents are a legitimate concern of the Providence City Council.

As a graduate of Harvard Law School, I have only the highest regard for Harvard and its administrators.
