AN ORDINANCE IN AMENDMENT OF CHAPTER 1087 OF THE ORDINANCES OF 1957 AND SECTION 17-76 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE, INCREASING ALLOWANCE FOR INJURED EMPLOYEES TO TWO THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$2,500.00).

Approved January 14, 1977

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

An ordinance in amendment of Chapter 1087 of the Ordinances of 1957 and Section 17-76 of the Code of the City of Providence.

The second sentence of said ordinance shall read as follows:

Except as otherwise provided, such allowance shall not exceed the sum of Two Thousand Five Hundred (\$2,500.00) Dollars in all to any one person during the continuance of his injury or disability.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and shall be retroactive to July 1, 1976.
