



BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the said spaces be appropriately identified by Signs indicating the same, reserved for the said purpose.

On behalf of Mayor Cianci I am asking that the following information be placed in the form of a resolution to be presented to the City Council at their next meeting.

I am requesting that five (5) parking spaces on the service road located between the back of the Holiday Inn and the Providence Civic Center be reserved for physically handicapped individuals attending an event at the Civic Center. The five parking spaces would begin at the service road and extend southward toward the middle of the Civic Center with the spaces reserved on the Civic Center side of the street. The reserved spaces would be clearly indicated as reserved for physically handicapped by signs put up by the City's Traffic Engineering Department. It has been brought to our attention that the action is needed because of the lack of adequate parking facilities in the vicinity of the Civic Center for handicapped individuals.

This request is submitted on behalf of the Paraplegic Association of Rhode Island.
