

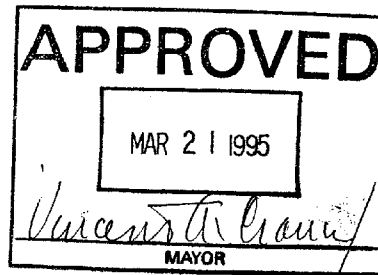

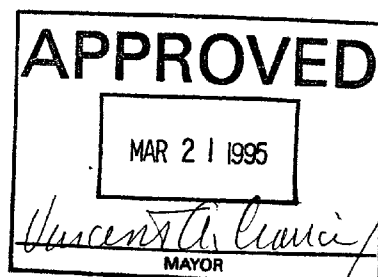

Councilman Jackson, by Request



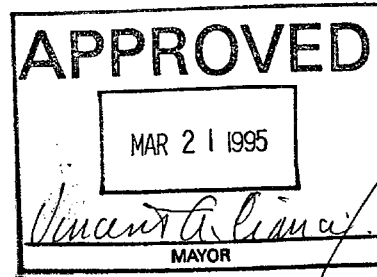
RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL
