AN ORDINANCE

Establishing the Classes of Position, the Maximum Number of Employees and the Number of Employees in Certain Classes in the Water Supply Board and Repealing Ordinance Chapter 1996-13, Approved April 29, 1996.

Approved November 15, 1996

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

Section 1. The number of employees in the Providence Water Supply Board shall not exceed two hundred fifty six (256) at any one time. Within each of the classifications, there shall be no more than:
