AN ACT RELATING TO NONPAYMENT OF PARKING
VIOLATIONS IN PROVIDENCE

which would deny anyone owing 5 or more parking fines to the City of Providence the right to register any motor vehicle until such fines are paid, and provides for an administrative fee to the state.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED (2) That the City Solicitor is directed and authorized to take whatever steps are necessary to assist in the passage of said act, substantially as set forth in the proposed bill attached.

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 45-6.1 of the General Laws entitled
2 "Non-Moving Traffic Violations" is hereby amended by adding
3 thereto the following section:

4 45-6.1-9. Nonpayment of fines - Providence. -- Any owner of
5 a motor vehicle who has Five (5) or more unpaid parking viola-
6 tion fines to the city of Providence shall be prohibited from
7 registering such motor vehicle with the registry of motor vehi-
8 cles until such time as all such outstanding fines are paid to
9 the city of Providence.

10 The state may charge an additional administrative fee for
11 subsequently registering such motor vehicles which fee shall not
12 exceed ten percent (10%) of the amount owed to the city of Provi-
13 dence.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.


