101 Thayer Street (Thayer Street Quad.) to facilitate deliveries to this area.  
Charlesfield Street/Saunders Gate, opposite 38 Charlesfield Street to facilitate deliveries to Wriston Quad.  
Thayer Street, west side, 144 Thayer Street (Refectory Dock) south to Benevolent Street.
