


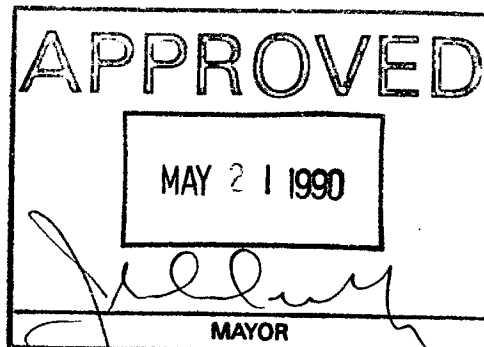
Approved May 21, 1990

RESOLVED, DECREED AND ORDERED, That the created Right-of-Way running north, south and east and being parallel to Silver Spring Street in the City of Providence, County of Providence, State of Rhode Island be received as a Public Highway and to be named at a later date under the provisions of Chapter 987, Public Law 913.

Being that cross-hatched area of land shown on that accompanied plan of subdivision in Providence, Rhode Island of Silver Spring Industrial Park for the Providence Redevelopment Agency prepared by Stanley Engineering, Inc., Scale 1"=100', dated November, 1988.

Said parcel of land is further described as beginning at the easterly line of Silver Spring Street running northeasterly and northerly to its northerly termination at a cul-de-sac located at Smithfield Avenue, also that certain parcel of land beginning at the easterly line of Silver Spring Street opposite Northup Avenue and running easterly to its intersection with said proposed road.

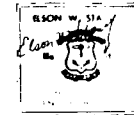

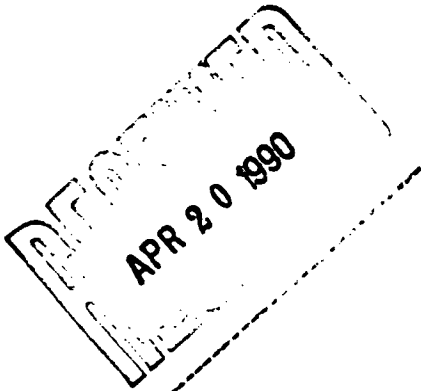
