EMERGENCY AN ORDINANCE IN AMENDMENT OF THE APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE CHAPTER 1976-38, APPROVED NOVEMBER 27, 1976, TRANSFERRING WITHIN THE SCHOOL DEPARTMENT, THE SUM OF TWENTY THOUSAND DOLLARS, (\$20,000.00) FROM ITEM 1 TO ITEM 0, AND THE SUM OF TWO HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS, (\$200,000.00) FROM ITEM 1 TO ITEM 3.

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

WHEREAS, the Adoption of this Ordinance, as an Emergency Measure, is necessary to Prevent a Deficit which would be in Violation of the Provisions of the Providence Charter Act; and further, that the said Transfer will Authorize Expenditures for School Department Employee Benefits, which are Reimbursable by State of Rhode Island Contributions, thus Reducing the Necessary City's Appropriation to the School Budget.

SECTION 1. Chapter 1976-38, approved November 27, 1976, entitled, "An Ordinance Making Appropriation of One Hundred Four Million, Three Hundred Thirty-Five Thousand, Two Hundred Forty Dollars, Sixty Cents, (\$104,335,240.60) for the Support of the City Government for the Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 1977, as amended, is hereby further amended as follows;

- Item 1 - Transfer Twenty Thousand Dollars, (\$20,000.00) to Item 0, and
Item 1 - Transfer Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00) to Item 3.

SECTION 2. This Emergency Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage by the City Council and approval by the Mayor.

Item 1, Services Other Than Personal	\$262,805.
Item 2, Materials and Supplies	\$34,292.
Item 5, Capital Outlay	\$28,882.

Transfer \$200,000 from Item 1 to Item 3

I am this day vetoing and disapproving an ordinance in amendment of the Appropriation Ordinance Chapter 1976-38 which would transfer within the School Department the sum of Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000) from Item 1 to Item 0 and further transferring the sum of Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000) from Item 1 to Item 3. I take this action because such transfer of funds would substantially increase the deficit in municipal funds.
