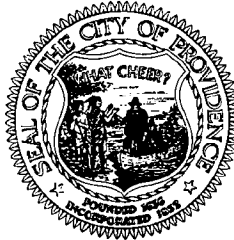
The Clerk casts one ballot as directed.

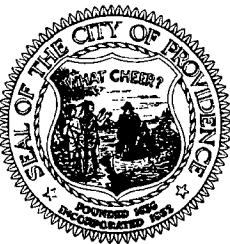

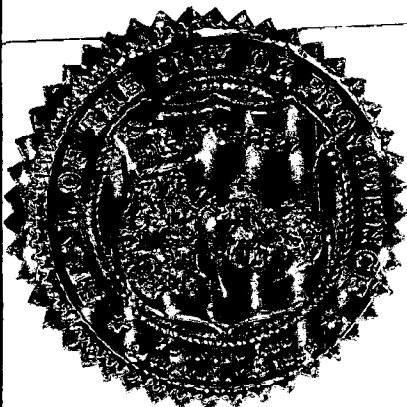
