Approved June 9, 1993

WHEREAS, John J. Leyden grew up in a cold water flat in the Smith Hill Section of the City of Providence and attended Saint Patrick's Junior High School and LaSalle Academy, and

WHEREAS, He joined the Navy in 1951 and served in the Korean Conflict, and

WHEREAS, Upon his return from the Service, he joined the Providence Police Department and began his career as a Patrolman in the South Providence Neighborhood, and

WHEREAS, In 1963, he was promoted to the rank of Detective and later served as a Detective Sergeant and Detective Lieutenant and was responsible for the creation of the departments first Arson Squad, and

WHEREAS, From 1973 to 1975, he was the Captain of the Patrol/Night Watch Command and he was then named Head of the Juvenile Division and in 1978, was promoted to Major and placed in charge of the Investigative Division, and

WHEREAS, In 1983, he was again promoted to Inspector/Major of the Night Watch Command which included Patrol Detective, Juvenile and Criminal Investigative Bureaus, and

WHEREAS, In 1983, he took on the duties of the North Kingstown Police Department which was then a very troubled department. But, under the leadership of Chief Leyden, has become one of the best run and most respective departments in the State, and

WHEREAS, John Leyden has now been selected to the President of the United States to serve as the United States Marshal for the State of Rhode Island,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Members of the City Council join the entire State of Rhode Island in commending Chief Leyden for this High Honor and expressing every competence that he will fulfill these duties with the distinction that has marked his entire career in public service.



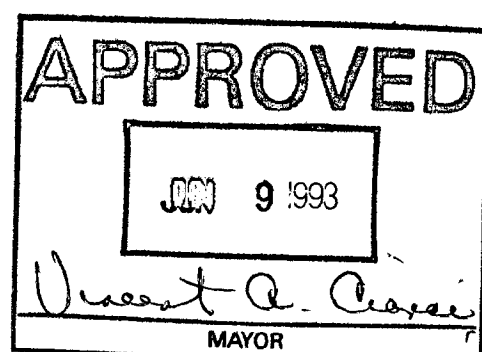

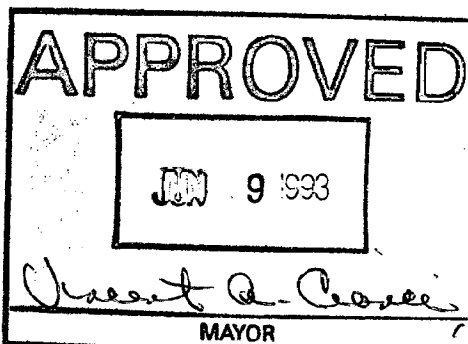
