### No. 726 AN ORDINANCE

Establishing the Classes of Position, the Maximum Number of Employees and the Number of Employees in Certain Classes in the Water Supply Board and Repealing Ordinance Chapter 1992-37, Approved October 20, 1992.

*Approved* October 29, 1993

*Be it ordained by the City of Providence:*

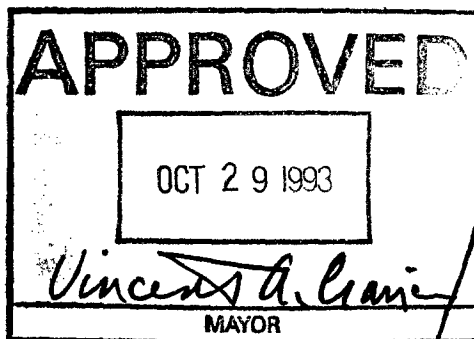
