




Dear Honorable Members:

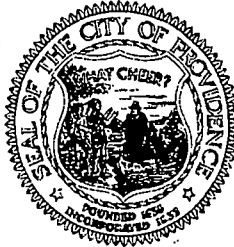




