

In accordance with the laws of the State of Rhode Island (Public Laws of 1948 Chap. 2067 approved April 30, 1948) and the Home Rule Charter of the City of Providence, Adopted September 18, 1980 (Article X, Section 1017 (a) to Section 1017 (c) inclusive), the following traffic regulation is hereby established:

SPRUCE STREET

PARKING RESTRICTION

A "ONE-HOUR PARKING 8AM to 6PM" area is hereby established on the south side of Spruce Street beginning at Dean Street and extending easterly for a distance of approximately 150 feet.

All regulations inconsistent herewith are rescinded.
