Dear Mr. Vespia:

Please accept this letter as a response to your Resolution of The City Council #495, dated October 9, 1973.

As you know, our Master Plan for relighting the entire City of Providence is still not totally complete.

Many of our major streets which have the old type mercury vapor lights have not been reached as yet; and Orms Street is one of them.

However, that portion of Orms Street from Charles to the 95 overpass is to be converted to the new underground type; a few already have been converted to the new 21,000 lumen Mercury Vapor type and the balance of the street will be converted as soon as possible.

The last major street to be completed was Manton Avenue, and I have spoken to the Narragansett Electric Company about Orms Street.
