RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 507

Approved November 21, 1966

WHEREAS, the City of Florence in Italy, internationally acclaimed as the Art Center of the World, has been devastated by flooding from the Arno River, causing exorbitant damage to works of some of history's greatest artists, and

WHEREAS, the City of Florence, (Firenza), whose Etruscan ancestry and Roman History, as early as 59 B.C.; the proud possessor of great collections of paintings, as well as sculpture by old masters, now finds itself in the wake of destruction by the raging Arno, its structures in need of extensive repairs; its churches and museums in need of redecorating and restoration and its collections of Objects of Art in dire need of early attention so that the damage will be minimized.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that His Honor Joseph A. Doorley, Jr., Mayor of the City of Providence, Rhode Island, is authorized to appoint a Committee for the purpose of formulating an immediate plan whereby this City can assist in the rehabilitation of the City of Florence, Italy, of which Providence has much in common as a center of culture, to the end that the recent untold damage can be repaired, and it can once again open its Art Collections to the view of those who appreciate Florence's contribution to culture.

CHAPTER

No. AN ORDINANCE IN AMENDMENT OF SECTION 167 OF CHAPTER 2 OF THE REVISED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE, RHODE ISLAND 1946, AS AMENDED ENTITLED "EMPLOYEES TO BE RESIDENTS".

Approved

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1. Section 167 of Chapter 2 of the Revised Ordinances of the City of Providence, Rhode Island, 1946, as amended, is herewith further amended to read as follows:

167.1 No person shall be employed, or continue to be employed, in any of the departments of the City government unless such person shall be an actual resident of the City of Providence, provided that this Section shall not apply to (1) Employees of the Water Department working outside of the City limits who are citizens of the State of Rhode Island; (2) Social Workers employed by the Welfare Department; and (3) Teaching personnel of the School Department; provided that in all of the above instances preference in employment shall be given to qualified applicants who are residents of this City.

167.2 In case of an emergency, extreme shortness in the supply of qualified resident personnel, or where the best interest of the City may so require, any department head may employ any qualified person without regard to the restriction in Section 167.1 for such time and upon such conditions as shall be approved by the Mayor in writing.

167.3 No person shall be employed, or continue to be employed, in any department of the City government who is an employee or elected official of the State or Federal government or the Providence School Department, excepting members of the Armed Forces of the State and Federal governments, the foregoing shall not be applicable to any present employees of the City who is presently an elected official or employee of said State; or a member of the School Committee who has held his office and been employed by the City at least five years prior to the effective date hereof.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
