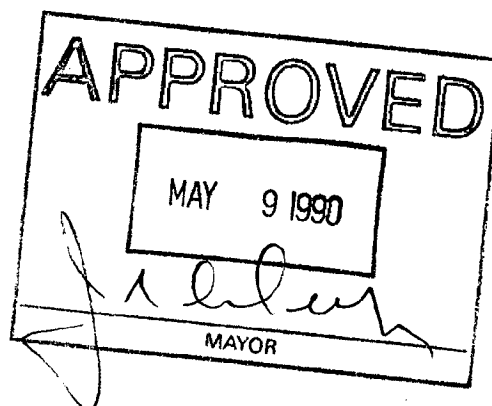

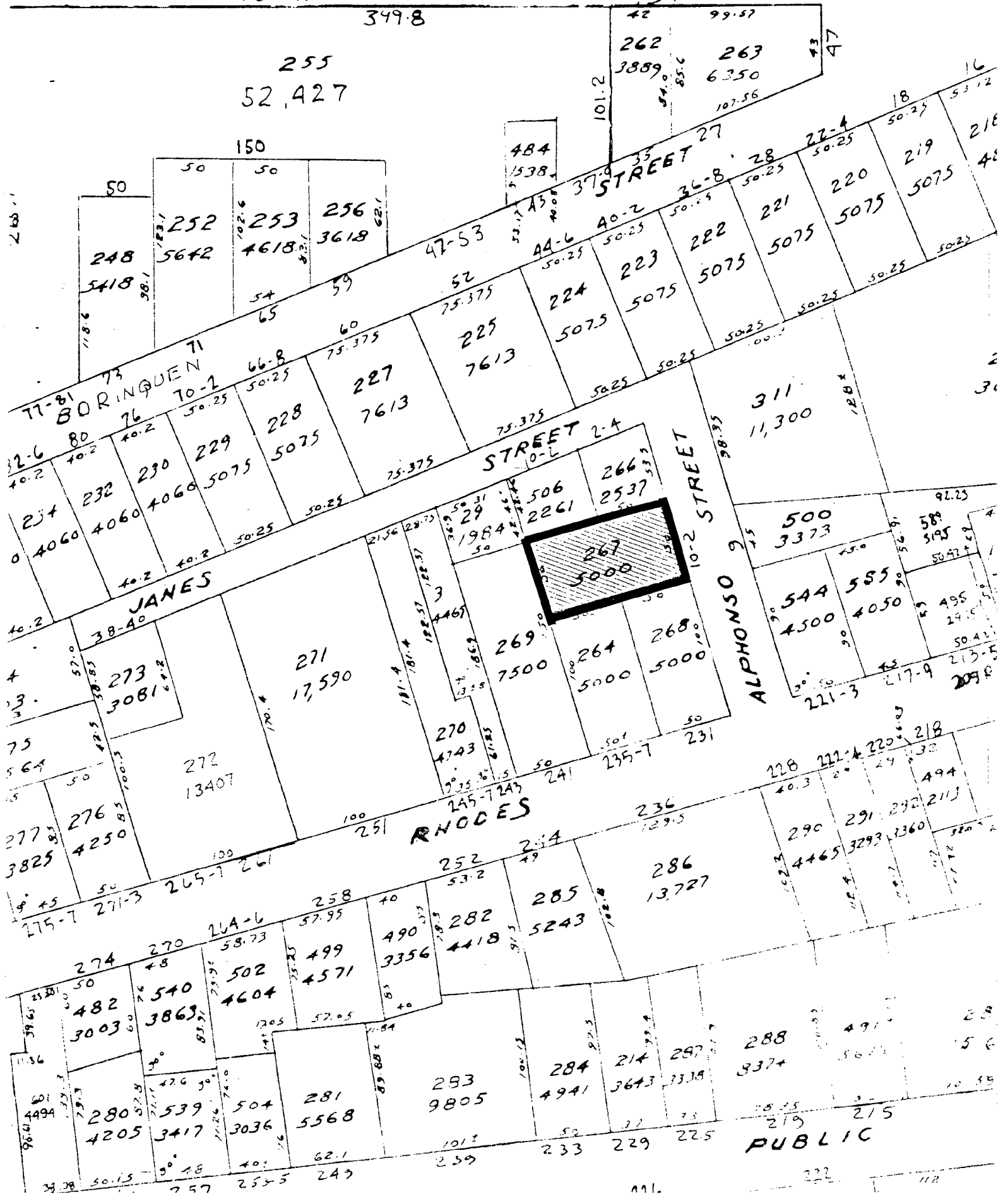



The Providence Redevelopment Agency has, as you know, developed the Silver Spring Industrial Park. In doing so, it has created two streets which must be assigned names.

In as much as the Providence Redevelopment Agency has sold two parcels and one building has already been constructed, it becomes necessary that the Council act as expeditiously as possible in naming these streets.
