RESOLVED, DECREED AND ORDERED:

That the following named highways shown as shaded areas on the accompanying plan entitled "Providence, Rhode Island, Department of Public Works-Engineering Office, Street Line Section Map No. 063531, dated December 9, 1971,"

viz:

Aborn Street (portion) from the northwesterly line of Fountain Street to the proposed southeasterly line of Sabin Street, Area (A-B-C-E-F-G-A); Broadway (portion) of the original layout easterly to the southwesterly line of Aborn Street, Area (C-D-J-C), Empire Street (portion), Area (D-E-J-D), having ceased to be useful to the public and the same are abandoned as public highways and the damage to the abutters is appraised at nothing and so awarded, and it is further

ORDERED, that the Director of Public Works, be and he is hereby directed to cause a sign to be placed on the above-named highways abandoned as aforesaid, having thereon the words "Not a Public Highway," and it is further

ORDERED, That after the entry of this order or decree the City Clerk shall cause a notice thereof to be published in a newspaper published in the County of Providence at least once each week for three successive weeks and a further and personal notice shall be served by the City Sergeant upon every owner of land abutting the above-named highways which have been abandoned, who is known to reside within this State.





Gentlemen:

This petition from the Committee on Public Works is a proposal for the abandonment of a portion of LaSalle Square. The proposed abandonment is a roughly semi-circular area containing approximately 9500 sq. ft. located adjacent to the western boundary of Lot 126 on Assessor's Plat 25. The petition is presented by the Providence Redevelopment Agency as part of its plan for the redevelopment of the Weybosset Hill area.

Inspection revealed that the land in question is not presently in use as a public highway. The proposed abandonment is part of a carefully considered plan for land use and circulation in this area.


