# RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 472

Approved September 26, 1989

WHEREAS, The City Council by Resolution No. 177, approved March 29, 1985, authorized His Honor the Mayor to execute an agreement, on behalf of the City of Providence, with the State of Rhode Island regarding the Memorial Boulevard Extension Project, and including the relocation of the Moshassuck and Woonasquatucket Rivers, traffic improvements, conveyance of land, and other matters relative to said property, and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to said Resolution, the City of Providence by His Honor the Mayor on January 16, 1987, executed an agreement with the State of Rhode Island entitled "Providence River Relocation--Memorial Boulevard Extension Project Comprehensive Agreement", and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to said Agreement, the City of Providence was to convey Parcel 9 in the Capital Center Project Area (71,902 sq. ft.) to the State of Rhode Island for appraised fair market value with an immediate payment by the State of Two Million, Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$2,500,000.00),

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That His Honor the Mayor is authorized to convey to the State of Rhode Island said Parcel 9 in the Land Evidence Records in Plat Book 1, Page 87 (Sheet 1 of 5), the City being authorized to make said conveyance pursuant to Rhode Island General Laws, Section 45-24.4-21 and the execution and delivery of the conveyance dated July 7, 1988, by His Honor the Mayor is hereby ratified, confirmed and approved, and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That said conveyance is conditional to and upon the dismissal of the pending law suit relative to this parcel.

PARCEL NO. 9

Parcel No. 9, as shown on the Plan, is bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the southwesterly corner of said Parcel No. 9, said corner being the intersection of the northerly line of the proposed Memorial Boulevard with the easterly line of the relocated Francis Street;

thence northerly bearing northeasterly along the arc of a curve having a radius of six hundred eighty-five and no hundredths (685.00) feet a distance along said arc and the easterly line of said relocated Francis Street of two hundred seventy-five and 30/100 (275.30) feet to a point of tangency;

thence N 5°-41'-29" E along the said easterly line of said relocated Francis Street a distance of seventy-three and 08/100 (73.08) feet to a corner;

thence S 82°-37'-58" E along the easterly line of said relocated Francis Street a distance of twenty and 01/100 (20.01) feet to a corner;

thence N 5°-41'-29" E along the easterly line of said relocated Francis Street a distance of thirty and 01/100 (30.01) feet to a corner;


thence S 82°-37'-58" E bounded northerly by land now or formerly of the City of Providence a distance of one hundred forty-one and 44/100 (141.44) feet to a corner;

thence S 24°-52'-36" E along the easterly line of said Parcel No. 9 a distance of two hundred sixty-five and 35/100 (265.35) feet to a corner;

thence S 65°-08'-25" W along the northerly line of said proposed Memorial Boulevard a distance of one hundred eighty and 75/100 (180.75) feet to a point of curvature;

thence southwesterly bearing westerly along the arc of a curve having a radius of one thousand one hundred forty-four and no hundredths (1,144.00) feet a distance along said arc and the northerly line of said proposed Memorial Boulevard of ninety-seven and 62/100 (97.62) feet to the point and place of beginning.

The above described Parcel No. 9 contains an area of seventy-one thousand nine hundred two (71,902) square feet of land or one and six hundred fifty-one thousandths (1.651) acres, be the same more or less.





RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING HIS HONOR THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE WITH THE STATE OF RHODE ISLAND REGARDING THE MEMORIAL BOULEVARD EXTENSION PROJECT.

RESOLVED: That His Honor the Mayor be and he is hereby authorized to execute an agreement, on behalf of the City of Providence, with the State of Rhode Island regarding the Memorial Boulevard Extension Project. Said agreement sets forth the obligations of the City of Providence concerning the relocation of the Moshassuck and Woonasquatucket Rivers, traffic improvement within that area, and other matters relative to said property, and

Be it further provided that such agreement shall require and include arrangements for retention of the World War I Monument in its present location or relocation to the southerly end of parcel 3 of the Capital Center Project or other definitive and suitable location to be determined prior to commencement of the project.

DEED

The CITY OF PROVIDENCE, a municipal corporation of the State of Rhode Island, for consideration paid, does hereby grant to the STATE OF RHODE ISLAND AND PROVIDENCE PLANTATIONS, all of its right, title and interest in and to a parcel of land in the City of Providence known as Parcel 9 within the Capital Center Special Development District, which parcel is described on Exhibit A appended hereto and made a part hereof.

Said Parcel 9 is also shown on that certain plan (consisting of 5 sheets) recorded in the Providence Land Records on January 27, 1983, in Plan Book 1, at Page 87 (Sheet 1 of 5).

The property herein conveyed is located within the Special Development District known as Capital Center, and this conveyance is made pursuant to Section 45-24.4-21 of the General Laws, the City Council having approved this conveyance and determined that this conveyance is consistent with and is desirable as being in furtherance of the plan of development for said Capital Center.

This conveyance is also made pursuant to a Preliminary Agreement between the State and the City dated October 8, 1985, as amended by letter dated October 8, 1985, and also to a Comprehensive Agreement between the State and the City dated January 16, 1987.

This conveyance is exempt from the Rhode Island Conveyance Tax under the provisions of said Section 45-24.4-21 of the General Laws.




