Dear Mr. Bergemann:

On January 23, 1976, I received resolution #830 from the City Council approved as of November 13, 1975, which reads as follows:

Resolved, that the Acting Public Service Engineer is requested to order the installation of Mercury Vapor Street Lights along Broadway, from Barton Street to Olneyville Square.

Therefore, I am requesting that you implement that portion of our Master Plan for relighting the City of Providence at your earliest convenience by removing the old 15000 lumen Mercury Vapor lights and install your proposed new 21000 lumen Mercury Vapor lights.

This is the area where the new school is presently under construction and of course Broadway is one of our busiest arteries for vehicle traffic in the City.
