No. 140 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE

CHAPTER 1350 BY ADDING THE SUM OF FORTY THREE THOUSAND (\$43,000) TO THE APPROPRIATION FOR PAYMENTS TO BLUE CROSS AND PHYSICIANS' SERVICE.

Approved February 16, 1961

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1. Chapter 1350 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence as approved September 16, 1960, entitled: "An Ordinance Making Appropriation of \$40,869,634.16 for the Support of the City Government for the Fiscal Year Ending September 30, 1961", as amended, is hereby further amended by adding the sum of Forty Three Thousand (\$43,000) Dollars to the appropriation for PAYMENTS TO BLUE CROSS AND PHYSICIANS' SERVICE.

SECTION 2. The said sum of Forty Three Thousand (\$43,000) Dollars as thus added and appropriated shall be obtained by authorizing and directing the City Controller and City Treasurer to transfer a like amount from the Reserve for Extraordinary Expenditures to the Receipt Account.

SECTION 3. The estimated receipts from Reserve for Extraordinary Expenditures are hereby increased by Forty Three Thousand (\$43,000) Dollars.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.

AMENDING THE APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE

CHAPTER 1350 BY ADDING THE SUM OF SIXTY THOUSAND (\$60,000)

DOLLARS TO THE APPROPRIATION FOR SEWAGE DISPOSAL SECTION, ITEM 1.

Approved February 16, 1961

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1. Chapter 1350 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence as approved September 16, 1960, entitled: "An Ordinance Making Appropriation of \$40,869,634.16 for the Support of the City Government for the Fiscal Year Ending September 30, 1961", as amended, is hereby further amended by adding the sum of Sixty Thousand (\$60,000) Dollars to the appropriation for SEWAGE DISPOSAL SECTION, ITEM 1.

SECTION 2. The said sum of Sixty Thousand (\$60,000) Dollars as thus added and appropriated shall be obtained by authorizing and directing the City Controller and City Treasurer to transfer a like amount from the Reserve for Extraordinary Expenditures to the Receipt Account.

SECTION 3. The estimated receipts from Reserve for Extraordinary Expenditures are hereby increased by Sixty Thousand (\$60,000) Dollars.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.



RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 143

Approved February 16, 1961

Whereas, on the 5th day of February, 1960 the City Council of the City of Providence adopted its Resolution No. 62 (which is incorporated herein by reference as if more fully set forth) wherein among other things it resolved that the Providence Redevelopment Agency be authorized to file with the United States Housing and Home Finance Administrator an application for an advance of funds to defray costs of surveys and plans for the proposed East Side Renewal Project estimated in the amount of \$275,457.00, said urban renewal project to be carried out on a two thirds capital grant basis under the provisions of Section 103(a) of Title I of the Housing Act of 1949, as amended, and the Housing Act of 1954, as amended; and

WHEREAS, on the 8th day of July, 1960 the City Council of the City of Providence adopted its Resolution No. 311 (which is incorporated herein by reference as if more fully set forth) wherein among other things it resolved that the Providence Redevelopment Agency be authorized to file with the United States Housing and Home Finance Administrator an application for an advance of funds for the aforementioned proposed project to defray costs of surveys and plans in the estimated amount of \$526,721.00, said urban renewal project to be carried out on a two thirds capital grant basis under the provisions of Section 103(a) of Title I of the Housing Act of 1949, as amended, and the Housing Act of 1954, as amended; and

WHEREAS, on the 3rd day of January, 1961 the City Council of the City of Providence adopted its Resolution No. 3 (which is incorporated herein by reference as if more fully set forth) wherein among other things it resolved that the Providence Redevelopment Agency be authorized to request the concurrence of the United States Housing and Home Finance Administrator in the commencement of surveys and plans for an urban renewal project to be undertaken on a three-fourths capital grant basis in the proposed East Side Renewal Project, said urban renewal project to be carried out on a three fourths capital grant basis under the provisions of Section 103(a) of Title I of the Housing Act of 1949, as amended, and the Housing Act of 1954, as amended; and

WHEREAS, the United States Housing and Home Finance Administrator has granted federal recognition to the planning of the East Side Renewal Project, such recognition having been granted in view of the interest of the Providence Redevelopment Agency to undertake the planning of the project with non Federal funds under the three-fourths capital grant formula. Upon completion of planning it is anticipated that the Providence Redevelopment Agency will apply for Federal financial assistance to carry out the project. With the submission of an acceptable final project report the Regional Administrator of the United States Housing and Home Finance Agency in New York has indicated that he is prepared to request the United States Urban Renewal Commissioner to make a capital grant reservation for the project, provided such funds are available at that time.

WHEREAS, it is necessary to provide funds in an estimated amount of \$526,721.00 to prepare surveys and plans including, but not by way of limitation, the costs of title searches, appraisals, negotiations and other expenditures incidental to the acquisition of land, surveys and plans, legal services, taxes, etc. and administrative and overhead expenses of the Providence Redevelopment Agency, with respect to the proposed East Side Renewal Project;

RESOLVED, That the City Treasurer, acting under the direction of the Committee on Finance, be and hereby is authorized and directed to borrow from time to time, in such sums as may be necessary, not exceeding Five Hundred Twenty Six Thousand Seven Hundred Twenty One (\$526,721.00) Dollars in accordance with the provisions of Title 45, Chapter 32, Section 42, Title 45, Chapter 33, Section 1, Title 45, Chapter 33, Section 2, Title 45, Chapter 33, Section 4 and Title 45, Chapter 33, Section 17 of the General Laws of Rhode Island, 1956, as amended, entitled "Redevelopment act of 1956", and to issue the City's notes therefore, signed by him and countersigned by the Mayor and Chairman of the Committee on Finance, and to renew any such notes from time to time as the same become due. The money thus obtained shall be used exclusively by the Providence Redevelopment Agency for the purposes of preparing surveys and plans for the East Side Renewal Project designated as account number 3-58-00.


