Approved October 27, 1978

WHEREAS, A native of Providence, he was the founder of the former New England Vending Company, furnishing vending machines for hospitals and schools for one-quarter of a Century until his retirement eight years ago, and

WHEREAS, He was awarded a Doctorate of Public Health from the University of Michigan and the recipient of the Golden Cup Award from the National Coffee Institute,
