It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 4 of chapter 869 of the public laws, approved March 12, 1926, is amended to read as follows:

"Sect. 4. All such assessments shall be made ~~upon estates~~ to the abutting property owners, upon that portion of any street or highway in which any sewer has been or may be constructed under the provision of said chapters and of this act, on a basis of seventy-five (75%) percent of the total cost of installing said sewers taking into consideration the following factors: cost of material, labor, mechanical equipment, engineering design and inspection costs (at time of installation); excepting any lots that have been previously assessed for sanitary sewer use. Provided, however, based upon seventy-five (75%) of the total cost of installation, the area upon which said assessment of two cents per square foot is made shall not extend to more than one half the distance between such streets or highways; and provided also, that when any estate is situated at the corner of two streets or highways, or otherwise so situated as to be assessed for the expenses of making a sewer on one of such streets or highways, that portion of such estate assessed for a sewer in one of such streets or highways shall not be liable to be assessed upon its area for the cost of constructing a sewer in the other of such streets or highways, but

only for its frontage upon such streets; and provided also, that no estate or portion of estate shall be assessed for the construction of any sewer, unless such estate or some portion thereof shall abut and be bounded upon the street on which said sewer shall have been constructed, or unless such estate has a right of access to said street or highway by a private gangway."

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

EXPLANATION

This act would allow for an increase in fees for the installation of sewers within the City of Providence.
