
Gentlemen:

This department has received the following resolution from your Committee and has taken the subsequent action:

Request: That the Traffic Engineer is requested to cause the installation of "No Parking 8AM to 4PM" signs along both sides of Rushmore Avenue for a distance of 50 feet from its' intersection with Manton Avenue.

Disposition: Since there is a blanket regulation prohibiting parking within 25 feet of any corner, I will have posted two "No Parking to Corner" signs on Rushmore Avenue 25 feet north of Manton Avenue. If these signs do not eliminate the problem, we may have to extend the regulation to fifty feet.
