No. 174 AN ORDINANCE IN AMENDMENT OF CHAPTER 4 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE ENTITLED "ANIMALS AND FOWL"

Approved April 24, 1989

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION I. Section 4-53 of Chapter 4 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Providence is hereby amended and shall read as follows:

"Section 4-53. Control of Vicious Dogs. All vicious dogs shall be confined in an enclosure. It shall be unlawful for any owner or keeper of any mischievous or vicious dog to permit such dog to run at large or without the enclosure of the owner or keeper thereof within the city limits, without being properly leashed and muzzled."

SECTION II. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
