Approved February 21, 1968

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1. Chapter 1870 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence, as approved September 25, 1967, and entitled: "An Ordinance Making Appropriation of \$50,670,558.30 for the Support of the City Government for the Fiscal Year Ending September 30, 1968", as amended, is hereby further amended by appropriating the sum of Seventy Thousand (\$70,000) Dollars to the POLICE DEPARTMENT, ITEM 5.

SECTION 2. The said sum of Seventy Thousand (\$70,000) Dollars as thus added and appropriated shall be obtained by authorizing and directing the City Controller and City Treasurer to transfer a like amount from the Reserve for Extraordinary Expenditures Account to the Receipt Account.

SECTION 3. The estimated receipts from the Reserve for Extraordinary Expenditures Account are hereby increased by Seventy Thousand (\$70,000) Dollars.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.

SECTION 1. Chapter 1870 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence as approved September 25, 1967, and entitled: "An Ordinance Making Appropriation of \$50,670,558.30 for the Support of the City Government for the Fiscal Year Ending September 30, 1968", as amended, is hereby further amended by appropriating the sum of Two Thousand Six Hundred Thirteen and 56/100 (\$2,613.56) Dollars to the account known as, "MARY ELIZABETH SHARPE TREE FUND".

SECTION 2. The said sum of Two Thousand Six Hundred Thirteen and 56/100 (\$2,613.56) Dollars as hereby appropriated shall be charged to the General Fund from Funds Not Otherwise Appropriated.

SECTION 3. The City Controller and the City Treasurer are hereby authorized and directed to transfer this appropriation from the General Fund to the account in the Trust and Special Funds known as, "Mary Elizabeth Sharpe Tree Fund".

CHAPTER 58-6

No. **58** AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 544 OF 1951, BY CHANGING FROM AN R-3 GENERAL RESIDENCE ZONE TO A C-4 HEAVY COMMERCIAL ZONE, LOTS 488 AND 489, AS SET OUT AND DELINEATED ON CITY ASSESSOR'S PLAT 108, LOCATED ALONG PLAINFIELD STREET AT DUNFORD STREET.

Approved February 21, 1968

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1. The Zoning Map accompanying and made a part of Chapter 544 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence, approved September 21, 1951, as heretofore amended, and entitled "An Ordinance Zoning the City of Providence and Establishing Use, Height and Area Regulations", is hereby further amended by changing from an R-3 General Residence Zone to a C-4 Heavy Commercial Zone, Lots 488 and 489, as set out and delineated on City Assessor's Plat 108, located along Plainfield Street at Dunford Street, bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the southeasterly corner of Plainfield and Dunford streets; thence easterly along the southerly line of Plainfield Street to the northeasterly corner of Lot 488 on City Assessor's Plat 108; thence southerly along the westerly line of Lot 487 to the southeasterly corner of Lot 488; thence westerly along the northerly line of Lot 490 to the easterly line of Dunford Street at the southwesterly corner of Lot 489; thence northerly along the easterly line of Dunford Street to the southeasterly corner of Dunford and Plainfield streets at the northwesterly corner of Lot 489 and the point and place of beginning.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.

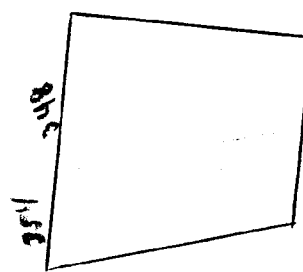

SUBJECT: Referral No. 1655 - ZONING CHANGE ON PLAINFIELD AND DUNFORD
STREETS

Gentlemen:

The subject referral received consideration by the City Plan Commission at a meeting held on Tuesday, November 7, 1967.

This referral is a request for a change of zone from an R-3 Zone to a C-4 Zone Lots 488 and 489 on Assessor's Plat 108 located on Plainfield and Dunford Streets.

On an inspection and photographic survey it was determined that Lot 488 contained a 1½-story frame dwelling and a 3-story frame dwelling in fair condition and Lot 489 was vacant and undeveloped except for a few automobiles.

These lots are located in an R-3 Medium Density Residential Zone. The new proposed zoning is for these lots to remain in the R-3 Residential Zone. There is extensive spot zoning already in this area and any further increase, such as C-4 Heavy Commercial Zone which is requested in this petition, would thus decrease surrounding residential property values.


The Commission



The subject referral received consideration by the City Plan Commission at a meeting held on Tuesday, November 7, 1967.

This referral is a request for a change in zone from an R-2 Residential Zone to a C-2 Commercial Zone of Lots 42 and 43 on Assessor's Plat 88 located at 1045-1051 Elmwood Avenue.


On an inspection and photographic survey it was determined that Lot 42 contained a 3-story dwelling and Lot 43 was vacant and undeveloped.

The properties are located in a medium density zone. It is important that the Ordinance be upheld as a means of assuring stability to this zone. Converting these two lots into a commercial zone would affect property values and the environmental character of the neighborhood. The granting of this petition would extend a commercial type operation, moving noise and vibrations closer to residential homes and Roger Williams Park which is directly across Elmwood Avenue.

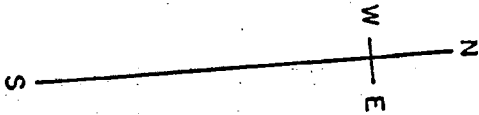

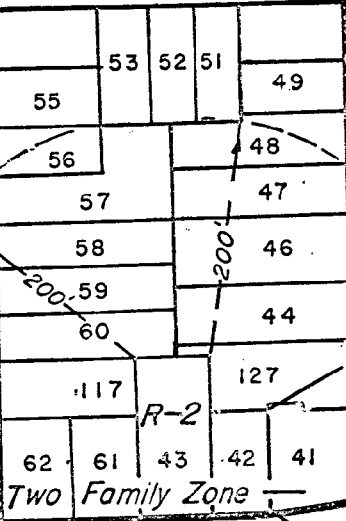
