

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 115

Approved February 9, 1995

RESOLVED, That the Traffic Engineer is requested to prohibit motor vehicle traffic along various streets located in the vicinity of Brown University beginning on Saturday, September 17, 1994, between the hours of 6:30 o'clock A.M. and 6:30 o'clock P.M. to accommodate Football Season, as follows:

Suggested Traffic Regulations:

One Way Traffic:

Sessions Street, One Way easterly from Morris Avenue to Taft Avenue.
Taft Avenue, One Way northerly from Sessions Street to Savoy Street.

No Traffic:

Between Taft Avenue and Elmgrove Avenue
Sessions Street, between Taft Avenue and Elmgrove Avenue
Taber Avenue, between Emeline Street and Sessions Street

No Parking:

Aldrich Terrace, either side.
Savoy Street, either side, between Hope Street and Elmgrove Avenue.
Taft Avenue, either side, between Sessions Street and Savoy Street.
Morris Avenue, either side between Sessions Street and Emeline Street.
Taber Avenue, either side, between Sessions Street and Emeline Street.
either side, between Doyle Avenue and Emeline Street.
Stadium Road, either side, between Sessions Street and Emeline Street.
Sessions Street, either side, between Morris Avenue and Elmgrove Avenue.
Elmway, either side.
Doyle Avenue, one side-between Taber Avenue and Elmgrove Avenue.
Upton Avenue, one side, between Elmgrove Avenue and Wayland Avenue.

- Taber Avenue - Between Emeline and Sessions Street


No Parking:

**Parent's and Homecoming Weekend

All officers will report for duty at the detail time noted. Officers working the ticket booth may be relieved at half-time or when the ticket booth closes; however, in the event a need arises, Supervisor on duty shall make a decision to secure these officers or have them remain on duty.

The officers will be assigned to the following posts:

- 1 Officer North (visitors) side ticket entrance
- 1 Officer Student Gate - Sessions Street
- 1 Officer South (home) side ticket entrance
- 2 Officers South home track - roving
- 2 Officers North visitors track - roving

7 Officers Total (Plus one Supervisor)

NOTE: This year the gates on the tracks will be monitored by student employees of the Athletic Department, thereby allowing our officers on the track to rove and/or respond to problems in the stands.

A Supervisor will be in charge of each football detail.

Brown EMS:

On duty Brown University Emergency Medical Services personnel will be on site at each game from 1230 - 1630. Red Cross personnel will also be present.

- 1 Elmgrove/Sessions
- 1 Taber/Sessions
- 1 Marvel Gym at Elmgrove
- 1 Sergeant
- 1 Ticket Office

Officers should note that alcohol is prohibited in the stadium. The Athletic Department ticket personnel will be checking for alcohol as people enter. Officers at ticket locations are to assist in the enforcement of this policy. People observed with alcohol in the stands are to be confronted and requested to leave the stadium or dispose of it in a trash receptacle. This policy will be enforced by checking all obvious containers; however, officers will not conduct individual searches of a person or their clothing. The Sports Foundation has been notified that bars may not be set up, nor alcohol served, representing Brown University at any intercollegiate athletic event.


Prior to the game start, two officers will be assigned to the parking lots to insure that everyone leaves the lot and that drinking does not occur during gametime. Athletic Department personnel will be responsible for monitoring the parking areas while the game is in progress.

Officers must be on their individual post assignments by 1150 hours in preparation for the gates to open by noon.

Officers on the home side track are to strictly enforce the rule that only people with sideline passes will be allowed on the track/field area.

Any major problems or concerns should be addressed to the Detail Supervisor who should consult with Mr. Jeff Ward if there is a question.
