No. 636 **AN ORDINANCE**  
AMENDING SECTION 21-131  
OF ARTICLE VI, ENTITLED "TAX ABATEMENT  
ON REHABILITATED PROPERTY", AS AMENDED.

*Approved November 3, 1997*

*Be it ordained by the City of Providence:*

SECTION 1. Section 21-131 of Article VI, entitled, "Tax Abatement on Rehabilitated Property of the Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 21-131. Requirements for Qualifications. The category of property which qualify for abatement shall be:

1.) Abandoned buildings with back taxes owing that are required to be paid by qualifying homesteaders; 2.) Vacant property which formerly was the situs of an abandoned building; and 3.) upon which back taxes are owed; provided said back taxes are owed at least in part from the above-referenced building and for which a rehabilitation plan has been proposed and is deemed for the property.

The City Council shall determine the eligibility of each applicant.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
