Gentlemen:

Our records as of this date show a total of 14.74 miles of City/~~Town~~ maintained road on the State Highway System in your City/~~Town~~, which under the provisions of the revised law, Chapter 28, Public Laws of 1959 which allots \$1,000.00 per mile for each mile of such unconstructed road, to a maximum of \$10,000.00 in any year, entitles your City/~~Town~~ to the sum of \$ 10,000.00 during the current year for this work.

We are enclosing forms upon which the roads selected by you for improvement are to be listed and submitted to this office for approval by the Director of Transportation and the undersigned, before any work is undertaken.

The forms upon which expenditures are to be shown and submitted for our approval will be furnished to you with the return of the approved list of roads.

Upon satisfactory completion of the work outlined, we will prepare the necessary certificate and voucher for payment by the General Treasurer.




Dear Mr. Flynn:

Pursuant to the request of the Committee on Public Works, I have completed the forms on State Highway Entitlement Funds and forwarded them to the State Department of Transportation.

Upon examination of the form with streets listed, it is in accordance with the provisions of the public law, as enumerated, and mileage for the streets listed is accurate.

Although this entitlement does not completely cover the cost of sweeping and maintaining the list of streets, it is money that the City would have to expend under normal operating conditions. Unless a change in the law occurs upgrading the cost per mile with a maximum of \$10,000.00 in any year, I will continue to apply on a year to year basis for the maximum amount under the law for the City of Providence.
