SECTION 59.

The number of employees in the Office of the Mayor shall not be limited. The Mayor may appoint without reference to civil service provisions and without the necessity for approval by the City Council a Chief of Staff and such deputies, Assistants, Aides, Secretaries, Stenographers, Clerks and other personnel as he may deem necessary.

SECTION 60.

No person shall be appointed to, and the City Treasurer shall not pay, nor shall an officer or employee of the City issue a check for the payment of, nor pay any salary or compensation to a person holding or claiming to hold a position in the

classified service in any department which is in excess of the total number of positions or the number of any individual class of positions provided herein for the particular department provided; however, that with the approval of the department head and the Director of Finance, said maximum may be exceeded temporarily when regular employees are absent on vacation and the excess employees do not aggregate more than the number on vacation or during the absence of employees due to injuries received while discharging their duties as employees or during absences of employees on sick leave and it is necessary to employ temporary employees for the duration of the employees sick leave, or during the absence of employees who have been granted a temporary leave of absence or when in the opinion of the Director of Finance, a temporary emergency exists.

- SECTION 61. Where no maximum limit is fixed on the total number of positions or the number of any individual class of position in a department, the number of persons appointed and employees shall be determined by the unexpended appropriation available.
- SECTION 62. Chapter 1985-70 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence approved June 25, 1985, with all amendments and additions thereto, is hereby repealed and all other Ordinances or parts thereof inconsistent herewith are likewise repealed.
- SECTION 63. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
