

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 81

Approved February 14, 1974

RESOLVED, DECREED AND ORDERED:

That the following named highway shown as a cross-hatched area on the accompanying plan entitled "Providence, Rhode Island, Department of Public Works - Engineering Office, Street Line Section Map No. 063542, Dated February 11, 1972,"

viz:

Durfee Street from the westerly line of Harrison Street to the easterly line of Dexter Street having ceased to be useful to the public and the same is abandoned as a public highway and the damage to the abutters is appraised at nothing and so awarded, and is further

ORDERED, That the Director of Public Works, be and he is hereby directed to cause a sign to be placed on the above-named highway abandoned as aforesaid, having thereon the words "Not a Public Highway," and it is further

ORDERED, That after the entry of this order or decree the City Clerk shall cause a notice thereof to be published in a newspaper published in the County of Providence at least once a week for three successive weeks and a further and personal notice shall be served by the City Sergeant upon every owner of land abutting the above-named highway which has been abandoned, who is known to reside within this State, and it is further

ORDERED, That upon abandonment the Providence Redevelopment Agency shall grant to the City of Providence, an easement for sewer purposes over the abandoned land.

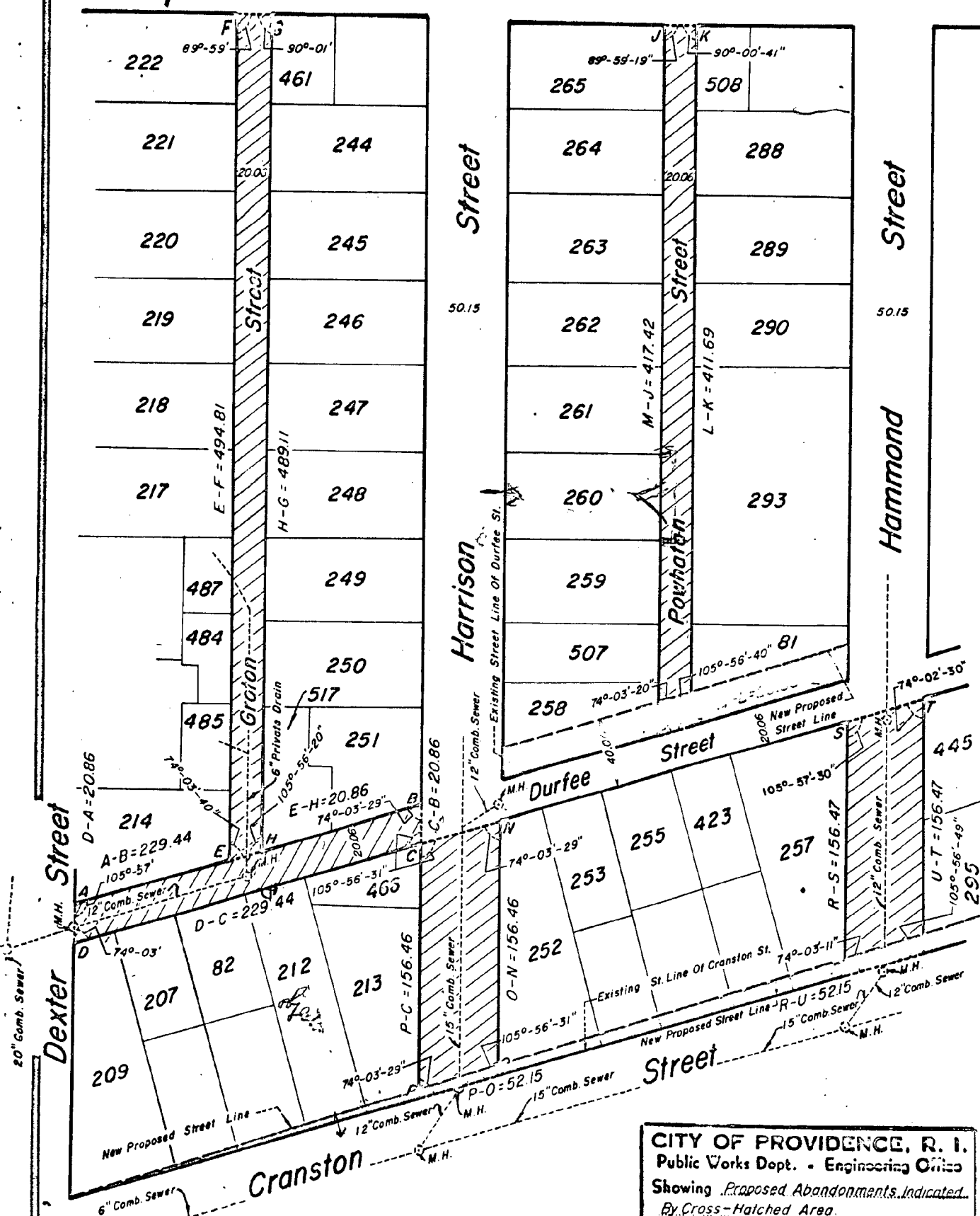

Dear Mr. Payne:

On June 19, 1972 the construction drawings for the West Broadway project site improvements were approved by the Department of Public Works. These drawings called for the abandonment of those portions of Harrison Street, Hammond Street and Durfee Street being considered for abandonment by the Committee on Public Works.

Based on this approval, the Providence Redevelopment Agency began to implement these plans. To date the portions of Hammond and Harrison Streets in question have had all utility lines removed. That portion of Durfee Street which is in question has been closed at either end by the installation of curbs and new sidewalks. The sewer line that passes under this street must remain in its present location and therefore the Providence Redevelopment Agency proposes that this section be maintained in easement.

Powhatan Street - from Division Street to the new proposed street line
of Durfee Street

Durfee Street-The Department of Public Works has no objection to the abandonment of Durfee Street from Dexter Street to Harrison Street, provided the 12 inch combination sewer within Durfee Street is no longer considered part of the Providence Sewer System.
