# RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 747

Approved December 29, 1978

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Committee on Public Welfare of the City Council is hereby respectfully requested to undertake a study to ascertain whether or not our multi-talented Senior Citizenry may be enlisted in private industry on a limited basis to eliminate their feeling of having been "turned out to pasture".
