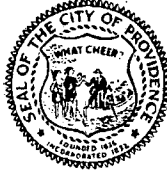


Please accept the enclosed correspondence dated November 24, 1992 transmitted to me from Mr. James J. Malachowski, Chairman of the Public Utilities Commission.


Dear Council President Petrosinelli:
