

Dear Pat:

To summarize our phone conversation yesterday, I hereby request that the following two city council resolutions be introduced:

- (1) to make parking illegal on the north side of Miller Avenue (Roger Williams Park side), with several signs placed noting that the ban will be strictly enforced with fines imposed; and
- (2) signs on Edgewood Boulevard indicating that the 25 mph speed limit will be strictly enforced. This should be undertaken along with a request that the Providence Police Department increase its monitoring and enforcement of speeding vehicles on this street. We should also look into the feasibility of installing a few speed bumps to coincide with the proposed repaving of this street.

Your prompt assistance on these two matters is greatly appreciated.
