An Ordinance in Amendment of Chapter 564 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence, entitled: "The City of Providence Zoning Ordinance" approved October 24, 1991 by Amending Providence Zoning District Map Number 105 of the Official Zoning Map by Changing the Zoning District Designation of a Portion of Lot 47 from C-2 to M-1.

Be It Ordained by the City of Providence:

Section 1. Chapter 564 of the ordinances of the city of Providence, entitled "The City of Providence Zoning Ordinance," approved October 24, 1991 is hereby amended by changing the zoning district designation of that portion of lot

47 beginning 114 feet, plus or minus, southerly of Plainfield Street, at the southwesterly corner of lot 46, then easterly, along lot 46 and 66 to Dike Street, then southerly along Dike Street to the northeasterly corner of lot 460, then southwesterly along lot 460 to lot 93, then northerly along lots 93, 95, 96, 97, 98 and 99 to the northeast corner of lot 99, then easterly, bisecting lot 47 on a straight line, to the southwesterly corner of lot 46 on Providence Zoning District Map 105 of the Official Zoning Maps from C-2 to M-1.

Section 2. Said amendment will correct an error made when the Official Zoning Map was prepared prior to adoption.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect upon passage.
