
Dear Ms. Mendonca,

In regards to City Council Resolution No. 470 requesting that police officials use prompt and appropriate action against the culprit, or culprits who were responsible for the setting of the fire where Lt. Charles E. Duggan suffered his injury, please be advised, the Providence Police Department was prompt and did take the appropriate action concerning this incident.
