WHEREAS, there exists in the Town of Scituate a very dangerous curve on Elmdale Road, so-called, south of Quaker Lane, which said Town of Scituate desires to eliminate, and

WHEREAS, to do so said Town of Scituate must acquire a parcel of land, hereinafter described, owned by the City of Providence, and

WHEREAS, said Town of Scituate has offered other land owned by said Town of Scituate, hereinafter described, to the City of Providence in exchange for the land requested to eliminate said curve, and

WHEREAS, the Water Supply Board of the City of Providence has voted to approve said exchange of land for said purpose.

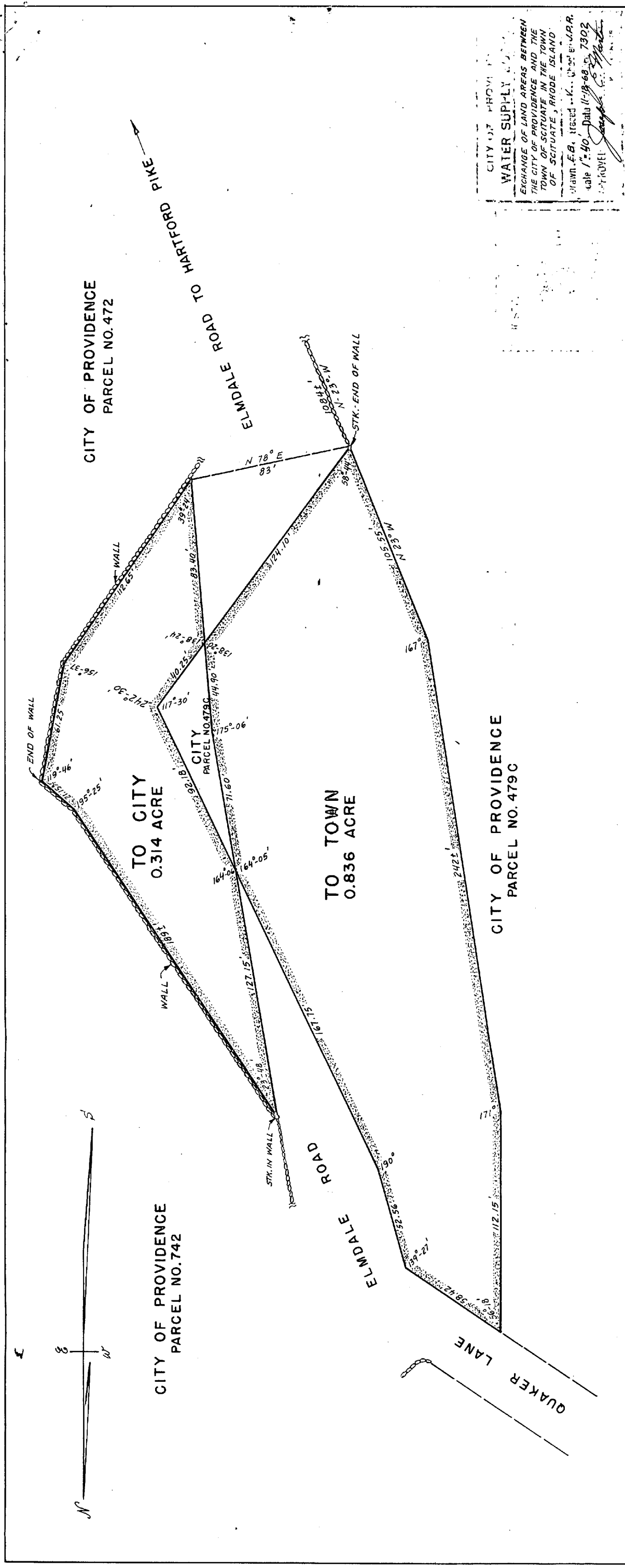
