No. 623 AN ORDINANCE IN AMENDMENT OF CHAPTER 68-82

OF THE ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE RELATIVE TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF SALARIES OF THE CHAIRMAN AND THE MEMBERS OF THE SCHOOL COMMITTEE.

Approved December 24, 1973

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1. Chapter 68-82 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence relative to the establishment of salaries of the Chairman and the members of the School Committee is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 1. The members of the School Committee shall be compensated at the rate of THREE THOUSAND (\$3,000) DOLLARS per year, commencing from the date of their appointment and qualification, and terminating when their successors are duly appointed and qualified.

"SEC. 2. The chairman of the School Committee shall receive a compensation in the amount of FOUR THOUSAND (\$4,000) DOLLARS per year, commencing on the date he was elected Chairman and terminating on the date when his successor is elected Chairman."

SEC. 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
